The Society of Women Engineers at the University of Virginia invites you to apply to our **High School Visitation program held on March 18th, 2023**. The program gives young women and gender minorities in high school a comprehensive look at the engineering field as well as UVA's engineering curriculum. Students will spend the day guided by current UVA Engineering students through pioneering speakers, tours of NSF funded labs, hands-on design activities, and much more.

While the program is designed to benefit participants with all levels of engineering experience, we particularly target those students who are not yet familiar with the field but may be interested in applying to engineering schools or pursuing engineering careers. Furthermore, our spring session is a fantastic opportunity for high school juniors to explore if UVA Engineering is the right fit for them before college applications are due next fall and for committed seniors to get a peak of what their next four years will consist of.

The spring 2023 session will take place in-person on March 18th at UVA's Charlottesville campus with an application deadline of February 17th.
